

Rules for Mitre 10 Mega Twilight Cricket.

- 1. Maximum of 8 players per team. Each player to bowl a maximum of 2 x 8 ball overs from no more than a 4-step run up. Care should be taken when bowling to women and children. No LBW decisions.
- 2. Batsmen to retire on completing 30 runs, but may return to bat with the last remaining batsman if everyone has batted and then must retire again if they reach 50 runs.
- 3. Helmets, with a face guard, are mandatory for junior cricketers (Under 19).
- 4. Taupo Cricket will supply each team with 3 balls and a scorebook at the beginning of the season. Each team will also be issued with a set of wickets; these are to be returned at the end of the competition.
- 5. The cost to register a team is \$300 and this is payable to Taupo Cricket before the start of competition.
- 6. OD Park has a <u>TOTAL</u> glass ban. Please ensure that all drinks are in plastic bottles or cans and that these and any other rubbish are disposed of at the end of the evening. There are bins by the small grandstand at the park. Failure to adhere to ban results in automatic \$50 fine, payable to Taupo Junior Cricket.
- 7. Coin toss, boundary lines and any other rules to be negotiated by Team Captains prior to the commencement of play.
- 8. In the event of defaulting, please contact Blair on 021 030 4464.
- 9. Cancellations due to rain and any other reminders will be notified on the Taupo Twilight Cricket Facebook page. Cancelled matches will not be played on another day.
- 10. Twilight Cricket has been designed to be played in competitive yet friendly spirit.
- 11.Please remember to send your results in to taupocricket@gmail.com by 5pm the next day, the \$300 registration fee will be refunded to the winning team of the season. There is also the Challenge Trophy that is up for grabs during a trophy match.
